'In Memoriam' Bench Policy

A request has been received to place another bench in memory of a loved one

Agree in principle to consider each application individually but must ensure that the benches are of natural material and are from the same period as one that is already there

There must be a concrete base under the bench and the bench must be anchored firmly to the concrete

The maintenance of the Bench is the responsibility of the family

The Council has the Right to remove and dispose of any bench that is a cause of danger to the safety of the users of the Cemetery
